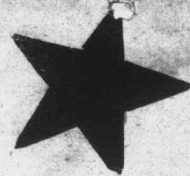

HIS STORY TO THE DETECTIVES  
He Represented Himself as Being En-  
titled to a Reward for Unearthing a

MONTREAL, May 26.—Yesterday a tall  
fair man, dressed in a rough gray suit,  
walked into the Central Station and asked  
Capt. Smith where the detective's office

story. He explained that a few years ago
