**Submarines**

Submarines have played quite as important a part in the naval war as average opinion has expected of them. Some critics nooh-pooed them altogether, and others believed that the battleships would have to sent to the marine stores. With the assistance of mines they have enabled the German fleet to remain safely ensconced in the Kiel Harbor without fear of British raids, which, but for the submarine threat, would certainly have been carried out. Credit must be given the German submarine sailors for their daring. The exploit of entering Deal harbor showed as much nerve as any admiralty could desire. Naturally the British public wonder how far the Germans may be able to go in submarine practice, and they would like to see a bit of retaliation. That will come in good time.

People who had thought themselves safe from all dangers, in the midst of a world devoted to the cause of peace, now find that across a narrow strip of sea a great armed power is gnashing its teeth in untrained Anglophobia, and desiring nothing so much as to cut the throat of the British nation. From a day to day persual of the German press it is quite clear the German hatred for France and Russia is a faint and lukewarm sentiment compared with German hatred for Britain. We have spoiled her time table; we have cut in before she was quite ready to tackle us; and therefore their hatred is two-fold. We have foiled so far, their present plan, but, above all, we are foiling their future plan, which was nothing less than to destroy and supercede the British Empire. Therefore if the Germans could they would work far more terrible havoc in England than they have wrought in poor, harmless, innocent Belgium. The British nation is waking up to the fact of this hatred which sings out cheek, like a blast from hell, across these narrow seas. Editorial in the London Morning.

**Water the Plants**

Water house plants thoroughly, but do not keep the pots in saucers filled with water. The saucers are good to keep the water from running through to the floor, but that is all. Apply water until it begins to run through and then stop. Do not water again until the plant needs it. Plants with their tops cut back require less water than those with a large, full top. Remember that flowers can be killed by giving too much water as easily as by not giving enough. As a general rule the temperature of a room in which window plants are growing should not fall below 50 degrees F. at nights nor go above 75 to 80 degrees in the day time.
