

INTERNATIONAL COMMISSION FOR SUPERVISION AND CONTROL IN LAOS

The International Commission for Supervision and Control in Laos presented its recommendations to the Permanent Secretary of the Royal Lao Government to the Political Mission of the Royal Lao Government, and has the honour to state that the Inter-Governmental Commission, Mixed Team of Experts has reported the following difficulties experienced by them in checking a convoy of trucks March 1966.

(a) No previous notice of the arrival of the convoy was given, but the team was informed only after a few messages had already been sent. These had to be called back.

(b) A general state convoy was mixed up with an armaments convoy. The team was not informed until after there were two separate convoys put back to find this out itself.

(c) In some cases, trucks did not correspond with those shown on the manifests.

(d) Some of the manifest mentions only "Ammunition" and did not specify any other details.

The above defects resulted in unnecessary delay to the convoy and avoidable inconvenience to all concerned.

3. The International Commission for Supervision and Control in Laos recommends to the Royal Lao Government to consider the following to avoid such incidents in the future:
