CONSTITUTION.

I. The name of the Association shall be the Maritime Press Association.

II. The objects of the Association shall be to promote the general interests of the journalistic profession.

III. The Association shall be composed of editors, proprietors, business managers and members of the regular salaried editorial or reportorial staffs of all newspapers or periodicals published in the Lower Provinces.

IV. The officers shall consist of a president, six vice-presidents, cor.-secretary, secretary-treasurer, and an executive committee consisting of the officers and seven others, all of whom shall be elected annually by ballot.

V. The initiation fee shall be one dollar, and the annual dues one dollar, commencing 1st January, 1889.
