Répondant aux questions qui lui avaient été adressées, l'Honorable Solliciteur-Général s'exprime de la manière suivante:

RE UNIVERSITY LAVAL AT QUEBEC.

"I am of opinion that the Laval University at Quebec is "not intitled under its Charter to establish itself elsewhere "than in Quebec, or to establish faculties of Theology, Law, " Medecine and Arts, to exist at the same time at Quebec and "Montreal. I think the Charter by which it is incorporated "establishes it as a local University at Quebec and that it " acts in excess of the powers and privileges conferred upon "it by the Charter when it establishes itself elsewhere. "There are various considerations which point to this conclu-" sion, amongst others, I may mention that the title is strictly "local, that the visitor is the Archbishop of Quebec, that the " Rector is the Superior of the Quebec Seminary and that the "Council consists principally of the Directors of that Institu-"tion. If it were in the power of the Laval University to do "what is contented for, great inconvenience might arise: " for all the senior professors who form part of the Council "might at any particular time be professors of the branch "at Montreal whilst the other ex officio members of the "Council were all at Quebec. Further it is to be observed "that express power is given to affiliate to and connect with " the University Colleges, &c., anywhere within the province, "and this I think is all that the Charter authorizes to be "done outside Quebec. It is to be noted that the word " connect" on which I understand reliance is placed as justi-"fling the action of the University Laval is joined to the "word affiliate by the conjunctive "and". The words are not "affiliate or connect". It seems to me clear therefore that "the Charter does not warrant a connection a part from an " affiliation.
