Lodge, an impression of which shall be deposited in the office of the Grand Recorder.

## OF BY-LAWS.

SEC. 58. By-Laws in conformity with the Constitution and By-Laws of this Grand Lodge may be made, and from time to time altered or amended, by submitting the same to the Lodge in writing, signed by two members of the M.W. degree, and having them read at two stated meetings of the Lodge, previous to being acted upon, when by a two-thirds vote, they shall be adopted; provided, they do not conflict with the laws or Constitution of the Supreme Lodge, or the By-Laws and Constitution of this Grand Lodge or the principles of the Order; and provided, also, they be submitted to the Committee on Jurisprudence of the Grand Lodge, and are approved by the Grand Lodge or the Grand Master Workman.

## ALTERATIONS AND AMENDMENTS.

SEC. 50. No alteration or amendment shall be made to these By-Laws unless the same be proposed in writing, at a regular meeting of the Grand Lodge, and adopted by a two-thirds vote.

## RULES OF ORDER OF THIS GRAND LODGE.

- 1. The hours of holding the sessions of the Grand Lodge shall be from 8:30 A. M. to 12 M., and from 2 P. M. to 6 P. M., except as the Lodge may by a two-thirds vote otherwise determine.
- 2. At the expiration of thirty minntes after the specified time of meeting, if there be not a quorum, the members present may organize informally, call the roll, note the absentees, make an order for their fine or censure, and may
