

MONTREAL, Aug. 1.-The Canadian Railway War Board announces that a detailed study has been undertaken which will show not merely the increase in the cost of railway haul in the manufacture of necessaries of life, crease in the cost of railway haul in the manufacture of necessaries of life, but will go into the actual cost of labor and raw material in the articles, with a view to proving that while railway rates have increased probably 30 per cent since the war began, while railway cost of operation has increased by a larger percentage, manufacturers have actually increased their rate of profit out of all proportion to the actual increase in their cost of production. The war board gives the following list:

Boots and shoes have risen in price since the war began, 100 per cent; beef, 35 per cent; clothing, 50 percent; coal, 100 per cent; clothing, 50 percent; coal, 100 per cent; flour, 90 per cent; gasoline, 100 per cent; flour, 90 per cent; pork, 75 per cent; sugar, 80 per cent, and tobacco, 50 per cent.
