Uncertainties of Price Regulations Depress New York Exchange.

New York, Aug. 28.—Stocks were freely offered by professional traders today. To the uncertainties and perplexities arising from the government's price and taxation policies, was added another severe decline in Russian exchange, rates falling to a discount in excess of sixty per cent.
