the interests of the Church with respect to Christian educa as opportunities should occur, and to make such reports suggestions to the Synod as it should deem advisable, this mittee is of opinion that in the following ways it might be powered more definitely to promote the religious trains our young people in connection with the principles of

First — By the establishment at Fredericton and St. Jo Homes or Houses to be kept and presided over, if possible Clergymen, at which children, especially from country par might be cheaply boarded, and from which, as your Comm have reason to believe, they might, upon the payment of a capitation fee, attend the public schools of one or other of Such Houses would combine strict discipline, with christian training of home. By way of experiment a su building might be rented at first at Fredericton and furni keeping in view the establishment of a permanent institu if the plan proposed should prove successful. In order to this suggestion into effect, the Standing Committee shou empowered to seek the necessary funds by subscription or wise. Any property acquired would belong to the Syno is very important, as this Committee believe, that such a stitution at Fredericton should be on a scale large enough afford accommodation to members of the Church atte either the Training School or the University.

SECOND — By ascertaining and suggesting to the Clerg others, the best means of supplementing religious teaching such children attending the public schools as might be with to receive it after school hours, either in buildings use schools, under the control of a Clergyman, or in schools by members of our Church.

Without desiring at all to limit the work of such a Communic which will to a great extent depend upon the amount of which churchmen are disposed to entrust to it, this contee submit the above as a partial but practicable manner tempting to "carry into effect the views expressed in the lution" under which they were appointed.
