RECOMMENDATION OF ALL LODGING HOUSES

At the conclusion of the inquest into the death of William Burroughs, found dead in the Gem lodging rooms, King Square, last Thursday, the jury recommended that all lodging houses in the city be licensed under the direct supervision of the board of health and that one of the provisions in the license be the compulsory registration of boarders.

T. M. Burns, secretary of the board of health, Dr. G. G. Melvin, medical health officer, and George Blake, chief of the fire department, gave evidence at the inquest. The jury returned a verdict that death was probably due to alcoholism.

Hum Poy testified that he owned the pellets and the jug containing the material which is supposed to be opium. He said that he suffers from asthma and he was given the medicine when leaving China.
