A draft deed of the property, transferring it in trust from Dr. Mathieson to Rev. William Snodgrass, Rev. W. Darrach, and Dr. Mathieson, in accordance with the provisions of Synod, 1845, renewed in 1851 thereanent, was read and approved of with this amendment, that the blanks therein for the insertion of the name of an elder of the French Protestant Church, Montreal, be filled up with the name of the Rev. John Emmanuel Tanner, he being a preaching elder.

The Symod adjourned to meet in this place to-morrow morning, of which public intimation was made, and this Diet was closed with prayer.

#### DIET III.

St Andrew's Church, Montreal, Friday, the Fifth Day of June, Eighteen Hundred and Sixty-Three Years:—
