- I. The designation of the Society shall be THE BRITISH ND FOREIGN BIBLE SOCIETY, of which the main object shall be to encourage a wider circulation of the Holy Scriptures without note or comment; the only copies in the language of the United Kingdom, to be circulated by the Society, hall be the Authorized Version.
- II. This Society shall add its endeavours to those employed by other Societies, for circulating the Scriptures through the British Dominion; and shall also, according to ts ability, extend its influence to other countries, whether Christian, Mohammedan or Pagan.
- III. Each subscriber of One Guinea annually shall be a Member.
- IV. Each subscriber of Ten Guineas at one time shall be Member for life.
- V. Each subscriber of Twenty-five Guineas annually shall be a Governor.
- VI. Each subscriber of Fifty Pounds at one time, or who shall, by one additional payment, increase his original subscription to Fifty Pounds, shall be a Governor for life.
- VII. Governors shall be entitled to attend and vote at all meetings of the Committee.
- VIII. An Executor, paying a bequest of Fifty Pounds shall be a Member for life; or, of One Hundred Pounds, a Governor for life.
- IX. A Committee shall be appointed to conduct the business of the Society, consisting of thirty-six laymen, six
