

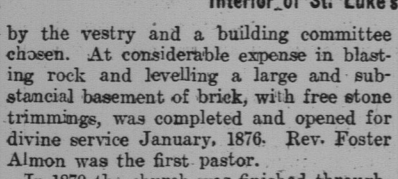

The exterior of the church is plain, but nothing has been spared to make the interior very beautiful. The chancel proper is approached from the basement vestibule by broad, easy stairways, with pined panels in oak, and richly worked black walnut newels and handrails.

The geometric arch is everywhere used—lofty in the nave, lofty still in the north and south chancel aisles; the chancel arch stands so, thus carrying the eye upward, and increasing the interest by architectural proportions.

The lighting arrangements are very effective; coronae lighting four ways being arranged under the girt moulding half way up the clustered columns supporting the arcade.

The bell of St. Luke's is the gift of Jeremiah Harrison, for 24 years a vestryman of the church, and others have contributed largely toward the internal decorations.

Flaveling, now rector of St. Thomas church, Providence, R. I.; Mr. W. H. Hayward-Smith, now studying for holy orders at Wyckoff College, Toronto; Mr. T. J. Lalonde, now studying at St. John's College, Winnipeg.

A special feature of the work at St. Luke's is the regular monthly missionary offerings taken on the first Sunday in each month.

St. Luke's has its representation in the foreign mission field in the person of Miss Rita McKim, who has charge of the Men's Hospital in Iloilo, Peris, in connection with the Church Missionary Society Medical Mission.
