An Act to amend the Act to incorporate the Members of the Medical Profession in Lower Canada, and to regulate the study and practice of Physic and Surgery therein.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend in the manner hereinafter mentioned the Act passed in the Session held in the tenth and eleventh years of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, "*An Act to incorporate the Members of the Medical Profession in Lower Canada, and to regulate the Study and Practice of Physic and Surgery therein;*" Be it therefore enacted, &c.

Preamble.

And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That for and notwithstanding any thing in the second section or in any other part of the Act cited in the Preamble to this Act, all persons resident in Lower Canada, and licensed to practice and actually practising Physic, Surgery or Midwifery therein at the time of the passing of this Act, shall be and are hereby declared to be Members of the Corporation of the "*College of Physicians and Surgeons of Lower Canada.*"

Who shall be Members of the Corporation.

II. And be it enacted, That upon, from and after the next election of the Board of Governors mentioned in the fourth section of the said Act, three of the six members of the said Corporation who under the said section are to be elected Members of the Board of Governors, shall be taken from among the Members of the Corporation resident in the District of Three Rivers, and three from among those resident in the District of St. Francis; and that of the members of the said Board of Governors, not less than eight shall be resident in the City of Quebec, and not less than eight in the City of Montreal; and that at each election of the Board of Governors, every Member of the said Corporation shall have the right of voting by proxy.

As to Members of the Board of Governors after the next election.

III. And be it enacted, That after the passing of this Act, it shall not be necessary that a licence to practise Physic, Surgery or Midwifery in Lower Canada be granted in any case by the Governor of this Province, but that from and after the passing hereof no person shall practise Physic, Surgery or Midwifery in Lower Canada, unless he shall have obtained a licence from the Provincial Medical Board, who are hereby authorized to issue such licence.

Licences to be given by the Board and not by the Governor.
