

the purpose of erecting and operating such telegraph and telephone lines the Company may enter into a contract with any other company, or may lease the Company's lines or any part thereof.

5 2. The Company may enter into arrangements with any other telegraph or telephone company for the exchange and transmission of messages, or for the working in whole or in part of the lines of the Company. Arrangements with telegraph and telephone companies.

10 3. No rates or charges shall be demanded or taken from any person for the transmission of any messages by telegraph or telephone, or for leasing or using the telegraph or telephones of the Company, until such rates or charges have been approved of by the Governor in Council. Rates to be approved.

15 4. *The Electric Telegraph Companies Act* shall apply to the telegraphic business of the Company. R.S.C., c. 132.

16. This Act may be cited as *The Kettle River Railway Act* 1900. Short title.
