matter that is on our side. I showed your letter to President Linney and he said so far as he knew nothing was done

There is very little Liberal organization in this Riding; outside of the Towns. I don't think there is any, and no much in the Towns.

Last year I interested myself in the matter and had some seventy five names added in this Town but this year I did not have the time to spare, and there did not appear to be anyone else sufficiently interested to look after it.

If we had sufficient money to pay the expense of sending two men over the Riding and have branch Associations organized at each sub-polling division and endeavor to revise a little interest in Liberalism, we might then expect to do something, but as things are at present we are not even in shape to successfully call a Convention.

The one thing we need at present is organization but there is a large Riding and a rough Country and to have travel it involves a lot of hard work and considerable expense, and there is such a large conservative majority against us that only the staunchest Liberals take any interest in the party.
