In view of the diremstances set forth in your letter of the 19th ultimo, the Department approves of your arrangeing to have a man go to Carlyle with a view to obtaining evidence in regard to liquor matters which will lead to the conviction of parties guilty of supplying liquor to Indians of Moose Mountain Agency. The Department observes that the expenditure in this connection may amount to between \$200.00 and \$300.00, The expence should, of course, be kept 127 as reasonable limits as possible compatible with efficient service.
