

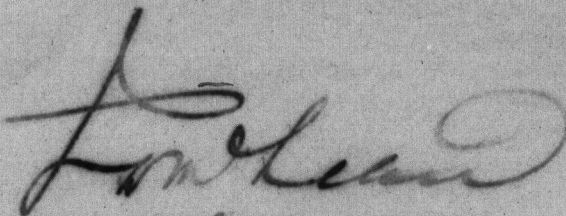

Ottawa, January 2th 1913.

Sir,-

In view of the circumstances set forth in your letter of the 19th ultimo, the Department approves of your arranging to have a man go to Carlyle with a view to obtaining evidence in regard to liquor matters which will lead to the conviction of parties guilty of supplying liquor to Indians of Moose Mountain Agency. The Department observes that the expenditure in this connection may amount to between \$200.00 and \$300.00. The <sup>within</sup> expence should, of course, be kept ~~in~~ as reasonable limits as possible compatible with efficient service.
