
Ottawa, 13th July 1916

Sir,-

With further reference to your letter of the 13th November last regarding an addition of 1.27 acres required by the Pacific Great Eastern Railway Company for ballast purposes on the Clinton Indian Reserve No.2 I beg to say this extra land has been valued at \$10.00 per acre. I have to request you to be good enough to forward payment for this land (\$12.70).

In this connection I desire to refer you to a report of a Committee of the Honourable the Executive Council approved by His Honour the Lieutenant Governor on the 26th August 1915, conveying the reversionary interest of your right of way through this reserve. As the area is now changed to 27.08 acres it will be necessary for you to procure another Order-in-Council or to have this one amended.
