from date permission was given, viz: September 9th,1929 to September 9th,1930, and from September 9th,1930 to September 9th,1931.

The Indenture under discussion is not between the Department and the Municipality, but between Mr. Rounds and the Municipality, and the 12.00 per annum referred to by you is not payable to us but to Mr. Rounds, the Lessor. We are only asked to agree to his receiving this \$12.00 from them, for entry upon his lease, while in their turn the Municipality have agreed to pay us the \$25.00 for use of the said portion of land. It was upon the understanding that the Municipality should pay this \$25.00 that the Indians of the Semiahmoo Band agreed to the sub-lease.

I am forwarding you herewith four plans to be attached to the Indentures, and would ask that two copies be returned to me, if the matter is now in order.
