

Q.193 Is a travelling salesman a military occupation?

A.193 Well, Sir, to explain that...

Q.194 I would like the accused to answer my question first, and then clarify the matter. Is travelling salesman a military occupation?

A.194 No, Sir.

Q.195 What do you wish to say?

A.195 I wish to say that if you give yourself as a soldier, you have to state on which ground you were going to be. Besides that, you cannot give your occupation as military, there is no background.

Q.196 A travelling salesman is not a military occupation?

A.196 That is right, Sir.

Q.197 You have produced to the Court, Boyer, a number of documents relating to this business of yours. These exhibits stating your business was registered in Montreal here, before the Protonotary. You also stated that you went to Quebec City to close your business or to make a business deal. Have you any evidence to substantiate the fact that you were in Quebec to make a business deal?

A.197 I cannot show any evidence, it happens to be food and food cannot be delivered until I am free to handle it.

Q.198 You have produced documentary evidence that you registered the business in Montreal, but you have not produced any evidence to substantiate the fact that you were in Quebec City to close a business deal?

A.198 No, I cannot, Sir, because it is food.

Q.199 When you were arrested by Sgt. Williams, of the M Police where were you?

A.199 I was in a room, in Quebec City at 437 St. Jean St.

Q. 200 Quebec City is roughly 170 miles East of Montreal?

A. 200 Yes, Sir.

RE-EXAMINED BY THE DEPENDING OFFICER

Q.201 I have one question. Will you tell the Court anything you know concerning a man in Quebec City whom you allege you went to see in business?

A.201 I saw Mr. Leo Rochette who is the owner of that company "Charcuterie Hygienique" and dealt with him. I have a contract regarding the supply of all the cooked meat I need in Montreal, here, as soon as I am ready to start my pickling business. I told him that I could not receive the first order before I go back to Montreal and have my discharge from the Army, but we did agree on the price the whole of it of what it is going to cost for the meat.
