FIRST WITNESS:-

K83931 L/Cpl LEE, E.F., 9 Cdn Pro Coy, CPC, being
duly sworn, states:

I am K83931 L/Cpl LEE, E.F.
of 9 Coy Cdn Provost Coys. At approx 2230 hrs 11 Jul 44, I
was in Godalming on duty when I had occasion to check a Cdn
soldier who I recognize as the accused for being improperly
dressed in that he was wearing a civilian ladies cardigan
over his tunic. I checked him, ordered him to remove
the cardigan and told him to proceed. At approx 2245 hrs on the same
night, the same soldier came past again wearing the same
cardigan. I ordered him to remove the cardigan again and
told him to proceed. He refused to do so and used abusive
language to wit "You are a cunt" and "You are a cunt".
I escorted him to the Provost Coy and he was
detained there.
