I have your letter of June 6th in connection with various proposed expenditures from funds of the Langley Band. Although it would have been preferable to make each of these proposed expenditures the subject of a separate communication and resolution, I am prepared in this case to deal with them in one letter as you have done and will have the necessary copies made for our files. The subjects might be itemized as follows:

- (1) Domestic water supply - sufficient information has been given to establish the need for the cribbing requested at a cost of \$152.00, and it is likely the Department will approve this expenditure.
- (2) Estimated expenditure of \$1500 for repairing the road into the Reserve. You might forward a sketch showing the location and extent of the road requiring repairs in order that the Department may be sure it is entirely within the Reserve and is not the responsibility of the Provincial Dept. Public Works.
- (3) \$600 for housing assistance to Clarence and Thomas Fillardeau. The Department will likely approve this expenditure subject to the two Indians concerned acknowledging the interest of the Band in their property to the extent of the assistance provided.
- (4) An expenditure of \$1925 for the purchase of a farm tractor and equipment. Information should be supplied with respect to the acreage under cultivation, crops raised and further acreage available for the extension

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
