Sec. 9. The result of every election of officers within the Local must be communicated at once to the Provincial Executive Committee, or where no such committee exists to the Dominion Executive Committee.

MISCELLANEOUS.

Sec. 10. All officers, boards and committees of the party shall be subject to removal by their constituents. (See Article III, Section 1, as to Provincial Executive Committee.)

Sec. 11. A member in good standing of one local shall have the right to attend and speak at any meeting of another Local, but shall not be allowed to vote.

Sec. 12. No person shall be nominated as candidate for any public office unless he has been a member of the party for at least six months, and has identified himself with the party by active participation in its work.

Sec. 13. No candidate of the party for any public office shall be permitted to accept any nomination or endorsement from any other political party, and individual candidates receiving personal eudorsation shall disclaim responsibility for same from the public platform.

Sec. 14. Any violation of the provisions of the Constitution by a Local shall be deemed sufficient warrant to empower the Executive Committee to revoke its charter.

Sec. 15: The order of business at ail business meetings of the party shall be as follows:
