The "number system" is at once easy and convenient. Parties of limited means, or who receive income at intervals may, by it, acquire in time a number of volumes and scarcely feel the cost, said volumes requiring only binding subsequently at such price as the subscriber may desire. Those requiring Histories, Illustrated Bibles, Mechanics' Guides, &c., would do well to adopt this plan. Agents and canvassers, from Quebec to Sarnia, deliver the numbers monthly at each subscriber's residence without extra expense.

Those who prefer the works complete at once, in volume, can have them forwarded on shortest notice to any part of the country. A chief attraction in all the works is the quality of the binding, and the superb paper, type, and illuminations. These are each in themselves only such as can be done in Europe and the United States, and are among the many reasons of their great popularity. The delivery of books in volume, in common with those in number, is also attended to by Agents, who deliver them as per order, and at prices precisely the same as if bought of the original publisher in the old country.

Considerable misapprehension prevails regarding the "number system," which it is the aim of the publishers to dispel. It is thought that books taken in numbers cost more in the end than if ordered in volume at once. This is an error. The price is one and the same. When works are issued in monthly numbers, the enormous sale from the system enables the publishers to offer them at the low price they do.

With the advantages indicated, and a confidence with the public already sufficiently established through years, the publishers re-solicit a generous support, and commending the accompanying catalogue to perusal, await orders.
