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EXPLANATION.

THE price per bushel will be found at the head of each page. The number of bushels and the number of pounds will be found in the column headed No. The value of bushels will be found at the *left* hand of the number, and the value of pounds will be found at the *right* hand.

EXAMPLE.—Suppose you wish to know the value of 32 bushels and 33 pounds of wheat at \$1.42 per bushel. By referring to page 70, under the price \$1.42, and opposite the No. 32 you have \$45.44, then running down the same column of numbers till you come to 33, you have at the *right* \$0.90, which, added to \$45.44, makes \$46.34, the sum sought.
