

CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS
OF THE
Montreal Woman's Missionary Society
OF THE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH IN CANADA.

ARTICLE I.

This Society shall be called "THE MONTREAL WOMAN'S MISSIONARY SOCIETY OF THE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH IN CANADA," and its central point of operation shall be the City of Montreal.

ARTICLE II.

The object of this Society shall be to aid in the Home, Foreign and French Canadian Mission work of the Church, and such other benevolent objects as the Society may deem desirable. For the furtherance of this end it shall endeavour to organize auxiliaries, which shall report to the Society annually, before the twentieth of March.

ARTICLE III.

The membership of the Society shall consist of all ladies, subscribing annually to its funds, either through an auxiliary or direct to the Treasurer. The payment of twenty-five dollars by one person, at one time, shall constitute a life member.

ARTICLE IV.

If they so desire, subscribers may allocate their subscriptions to any department of the Society's work, it being understood that the work of the Ladies' French Evangelization Society, on its present basis, shall have the first claim on the funds and energies of the Society.

ARTICLE V.

The business of the Society shall be conducted by an Executive committee, consisting of the officers, together with representatives from the city congregations, and also from the auxiliaries, to be elected at the annual
