Mr. Hegeman referred to the humanitarian work of the company in establishing visiting-nurse service, and distributing literature intended for the instruction of policyholders and their families on the prevention and cure of diseases and their families on the prevention and cure of diseases. The company's field and office force, embraces 14,000 persons, of whom 3,000 are in the home office. The office force is served with a lunch daily in its own office building in New York. The staff savings fund of the company, which is open to employees whose income is less than \$3,000 a year, has some 6,000 depositors and amounts to about \$1,000,000.
