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

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

The total revenue was \$9,268,234.99 and the total operating expenditure \$8,645,070.33, leaving a surplus of \$623,-164 66. Included in the expenditure chargeable to revenue was \$300,000 for renewal of equipment and \$150,000 for rail renewal. The expenditure on capital account totalled \$1,278,409.45. Of the revenue two-thirds was from freight earnings and one-third from passenger, mail and express receipts.
