XXVII. And be it enacted, That every Per-Felonies not son convicted of any Felony, not punishable with ble under the Death, shall be punished in the Manner prescribed by the Act or Acts, Statute or Sta-lating thereto; otherwise under tutes specially relating to such Felony; and that this Act. every Person convicted of any Felony for which no Punishment hath been or hereafter may be specially provided, shall be deemed to be punishable under this Act, and shall be liable at the Discretion of the Court to be imprisoned for any Term not exceeding Two Years, and in Addition to such Imprisonment, if the Court shall so think fit, to be either fined in such Sum as the Court shall award, or, if a Male, to be Once, Twice or Thrice publicly or privately whipped.
