RESOLVED, that the Bill as amended, do pass.

ORDERED, that Mr. *Justice De Bonne* and Mr. *Papineau*, do carry the Bill to the Legislative Council, and acquaint them, that this House hath agreed to the same, with some amendments; to which amendments this House doth desire the concurrence of the Legislative Council.

On motion of Mr. *Dumas*, seconded by Mr. *Berthelot*,

The Bill to regulate the rights and forms of last wills and testaments, was read for the first time.

ORDERED, that the said Bill be read a second time on Wednesday next.

On motion of Mr. *Berthelot*, seconded by Mr. *Bedard*,

ORDERED, that Mr. *Berthelot* have leave to bring in a Bill to amend an Ordinance passed in the twenty fifth year of His present Majesty's reign, intituled, " An ordinance to regulate the proceedings in the Courts of Civil Judicature, and to establish trials by Juries in actions of a commercial nature and personal wrongs to be compensated in damages."

He accordingly presented the said Bill to the House.

ORDERED, that the said Bill be translated into the English language.

On motion of Mr. *Cuthbert*, seconded by Mr. *Papineau*,

ORDERED,
