BY HIS EXCELLENCY LIEUTENANT-GENERAL

SIR JAMES KEMPT,

(L. 8) James Kempt. Knight Grand Cross of the Most Honorable Military Order of the Bath, Lieutenant-Governor and Commander in Chief, in and over His Majesty's Province of Nova-Scotia, and its Dependencies, &c. &c. &c.

HEREAS the General Assembly of this Province stands prorogued to Thursday, the 6th day of December instant:

I HAVE THOUGHT FIT, further to prorogue the said General Assembly, until Thursday, the thirty-first day of January next, then to meet for the Dispatch of Business, of which all Persons concerned, are desired to take notice, and govern themselves accordingly

Given under my Hand and Seal at Arms, at Halifax, this 1st day of December, 1827, in the eighth year of His Niojesty's Reign.
