cution of this Act, on the Penalty of Ten Shillings Current Money for every Neglect.

And be it further enalted That if any Person or Persons what-soever, being of the Age of Twelve Years or opwards, being able of Body, and not otherwise necessarily prevented by real Sickness, or other unavoidable Necessity, shall for the Space of three Months together, absent himself or heitelf from the public Wood up on the Lord's Day, shall be subject to a Fine, that is to fay, for every Head of a Family Ten Shillings, and for every Child or Second Propositions, to be recovered, upon Complaint before any One of His Majesty's Justices of the Peace, who is hereby impowered to clute the same to be levied.

All Fines and Penalties incurred by this Art are to be to the Ure of the Poor of the Town where such Offence is committed, and the Joltice and Justices before whom any Person or Persons shall be convicted of offending against this Act, are required to make a Record thereof, i. a Book to be kept by him or them.

Provided, That no Person shall be prosecuted for any Official before mentioned, unless they be prosecuted for the same within Ien Day, after the Offence committed.

And be it further enabled, That every Justice of the Peace shall have full Power and Authority, either supon his own View, or other legal Conviction of any Offender or Offender's against this Act or any lat thereof, to levy the Penalties herein before respectively mentioned, in Case the same shall not, upon such conviction, be paid by the Offender or Offenders, by distress and Sale of the Offender or Offender Goods and Chattels with Costs; and in Default of Distress, to commit such Offender or Offenders to the common Gaol of the County, there to remain in close Confinement for a Time not exceeding Forty eight Hours, nor less than Twenty four Hours.

And be it further enacted, That this Act shall be publically read Four Times in every Year, viz. At the opening of every Court of G neral Sessions of the Peace, immediately after the Grand Jury are sworn: And and also twice every Year, viz On every First Sunday of December, on every First Sunday in June, in all public Places of Worship within this Province, immediately after divine Service.
