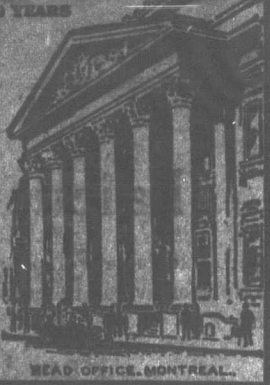

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History of Each Canadian Unit

The Canadian War Records Office, London, has undertaken the publication of a short history of each of the Canadian units which served in France. The proceeds are being expended in aid of the Canadian War Memorials Fund. The first little book of this series, by Mr. Stuart Martin, is "The Story of the 13th Battalion," the first war unit of the 5th Royal Highlanders of Montreal, from 1914 to 1917.

This battalion recruited to full strength within three weeks of the declaration of war and arrived in England on October 16. Here they put up with the mud and discomforts of Salisbury and finally sailed for France on February 19. They came into the line at Arras on February 24.

The first action was at the second battle of Ypres, where they and so many other battalions of Canadians "saved the situation" in the words of Field Marshal Lord French.

There follows accounts of their share in Festubert, Sanctuary Wood, on the Somme in 1916, and at Vimy and Lens in 1917, besides the smaller engagements of Kenora, Montreal, Regina and Winnipeg Trenches and Hill 70.

The booklet of 20 pages is well gotten-up, and has as the front-piece a picture of Brig.-Gen. F. O. Loomis, who was the first O.C. Other books of the series already published give the stories of the 10th, 28th and the Princess Pals. There is also a booklet of the series, "Canada's Triumph," which gives the details of the fighting at Amiens, Arras and Cambrai.
