AUSTRIANS ON SHORT RATIONS.

AMSTERDAM, July 12. The alarming state of the food situation in Vienna is described in a despatch to the Berlin Tageblatt from its Vienna correspondent, who says: The daily rations per head are fixed at approximately three ounces of bread and flour substitutes: one ounce of meat. less than a quarter ounce of fat, two and a half ounces of potatoes, threequarters of an ounce of jam, and a quarter of an ounce of war coffee, making a total daily allowance of seven and three quarter ounces. These rations may be supplemented by recourse to secret channels and by the payment of exorbitant prices, the carespondent declares.




