Are Farmers Growing Richer?

Farmer asks the standing of Ontario farmers today as compared with ten years ago.

Ans.: Principal Creelman, of the Ontario Agricultural College, Guelph, in his address before the Canadian Club, of Boston, gave these figures. He said that in 1866 the farmers of Ontario produced of beef, bacon and cheese products \$31,000,000 worth. In 1906 this had increased to \$65,500,000 worth. The value of Ontario farms, farm buildings, implements and stock, was over \$1,000,000,000, and the products of these farms last year (1906) was about \$300,000,000.
