### COLLEGE OF PHYSICIANS & SURGEONS, P. Q.

The triennial meeting of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec will be held in the town of Three Rivers, on Wednesday the 11th July, instant, for the purpose of electing a Board of Governors for the ensuing three years. We hope to see a full meeting, and that all the various districts and cities will be well represented. It must be borne in mind that no member of the profession is eligible for election to the Governing Board unless, nor until, he shall have been four years a member of the College. There is no getting over this clause in the act: "The said Board of Governors of the College of Physicians and Surgeons shall have the power—To fix the period of probation which persons must undergo before being eligible for election as Governors of the College, which period shall not be less than four years,"—or, in other words, the Board of Governors have the power of fixing the period, but it must not be less than four years. It has been stated that persons becoming members, who have been licentiates for four years are eligible for election, this is neither in the spirit nor the wording of the act. The College of Physicians and Surgeons of Lower Canada was not a close corporation, all Licentiates of
