Dear Ambassador de Chastelain:

I have the honor to refer to discussions between representatives of our governments, including ministers, regarding the acceleration of the elimination of tariffs on certain goods under Article 401.5 and the amendment of Sections XV and XVI, Annex 302.1 of Chapter 3 of the United States-Canada Free-Trade Agreement.

I have the honor to propose that Appendix I to this letter, consisting of the U.S. and Canadian accelerated implementation Schedules, shall become a part of the Free-Trade Agreement and replace and supersede the implementation Schedules for those goods contained in the Free-Trade Agreement, effective July 1, 1993.

I also have the honor to propose that Appendix II to this letter, consisting of amendments to Sections XV and XVI, Annex 302.1 of Chapter 3 of the United States-Canada Free-Trade Agreement, shall become part of the Free-Trade Agreement, as agreed at the United States-Canada Trade Commission meeting of August 18, 1991 and in subsequent technical discussions. These amendments will be effective July 1, 1993.

I have the further honor to propose that this letter and the attached Appendices, together with your reply and its attached Appendices, which are authentic upon verification in the English and French languages, shall constitute an Agreement between our two Governments, amending the Free-Trade Agreement, and shall enter into force on the date of your reply.
