PROF. HUGHES: Direct supervision, both by the school principal and his colleagues in the school, also by by myself and by my colleagues.

THE PRINCIPAL: Do you find that to be helpful and us eful? PROF. HUGHES: Yes, in all my experience of teacher training for the last eighteen years.

THE PRINCIPAL: It was the conclusion of the Committee that the candidate for High School diploma who had that training was held qualified?

PROF. HUGHES: Yes, to this extent. We believe the school practice should be done partly in the High Schools and partly in the Grades with younger childrenwe do believe that. It says that at least one third should be done in Primary Schools, the first line of Page 313.

: It was suggested to us that putting them into Grades 1 to 111 was awaste of time, but 1V to X1, all right. I think that is a very sound suggestion. And that is the actual practice in our Department. DR. WO ODHEAD: Then, this should be amended, instead of 1 to V1, it should be 1V to V1.
