THE TORONTO WORLD

LIVE STOCK MARKET

With 4000 cattle on sale yesterday, trade was slow and in most classes lower. Packers were looking for some choice and good butcher cattle, but the prices were generally 25c to 50c lower than last week. The market for common cattle was drab.

The bulk of the canner cows sold for \$5.25. There was a very limited demand for stockers and feeders. Some breeders offered good colored steers, weighing 800 lbs. and upwards, would sell at satisfactory prices.

The best classes of butcher cows were wanted. The bull trade is very dull at present; there being practically no demand for heavy bulls.

For much cows and springers the better class are selling at satisfactory prices with ordinary cows hard to see. Prospects are about steady with most classes of cattle.

This is as the World sees the market for cattle at the Union Yards yesterday. There were some who regarded the market as a good deal weaker than indicated by The World's report, but last week's market could hardly be taken as indicating the general tenor of prices, being unusually strong, and another thing that must not be lost sight of was the lower quality of yesterday's offerings, an important feature in the case. In any event, the prices must still be regarded as very satisfactory and high enough in all conscience.

Many cattle were left unsold at the close, probably well up to 1000 head, but the men who sold out early and took their losses, such as they were, were probably the winners in the long run.
