Some Criticisms, But if is Read and Passed On.

Ottawa, March 21.-(Special.)-The Murphy divorce bill, which came up for its third reading in the senate to-day, met with some criticism. It was urged that the evidence had been loosely taken and that the parties to the case had been married twice.

Senator Cloran asked that the committee would only recommend divorce mittee would only recommend divorce on very serious and grave evidence. Last year they granted a divorce to a man who was not worthy of it.

Senators Lougheed, Kerr (Cobourg), and Wilson insisted that the evidence in the Murphy case had been weighed with the greatest possible care. The latter pointed out that the husband had done everything he could to reclaim his wife, but failing, was justified in seeking relief.

Senator Cloran asked if human sympathy was to take the place of divine law. Senator Wilson replied that he could see no interference with divinal law when they acted on statute laws.

The bill was read a third time on division and passed.
