

The secretary of the Commercial Travelers' Association of Canada has received information thru the treassury department, provincial legislature? Quebec, that a clause has been insertate ed amending act 5, Edw. VII., cap 14

"However, no such commercial traveler from any other province in Canada which authorizes commercial travelers from this province to do businesso in such province without a license, shall be obliged to take out a license, under this article."

Under this amendment commercial

travelers from Ontario are not required to take out a commercial travelers' li-cense in the Province of Quebec.
