Thus at the famous Randwick course at Sydney on September 29 the Australian Jockey Club Derby, for three-year-olds, at a mile and a half, was won by G. D. Greenwood's brown colt Biplane, by Comedy King-Air Mo-tor, with Micrton & Osborne's bay colt Bronzetti by Eronzino-Daisy Chain, sec-ond, and E. E. D. Clarke's bay colt Thrice by The Welkin-Teppo, third. Altho the race has \$25,000 added, only nine started. The winner was a great fa-vorite at 14 to 9 on, and won by two and a half lengths in 2.343-5. It is only a few years back since Bronzino was racing in England. A son of Marco-Flittery, he was then the property of J. A. de Rothschild, and in racing a copital stayer. He was sent to Australia in 1912 and is now an assured stud suc-cases, altho on this important occasion his son had to play second to Biplane. Comedy King, sire of the latter, is also an English horse, being a son of Per-simmon-Tragedy Queen, and was the win-ner of the Melbourne Cup of 1910, in which he defeeted 29 opponents and ran its two miles in 3.27%. considering adopting a unitariate of twenty players. 
