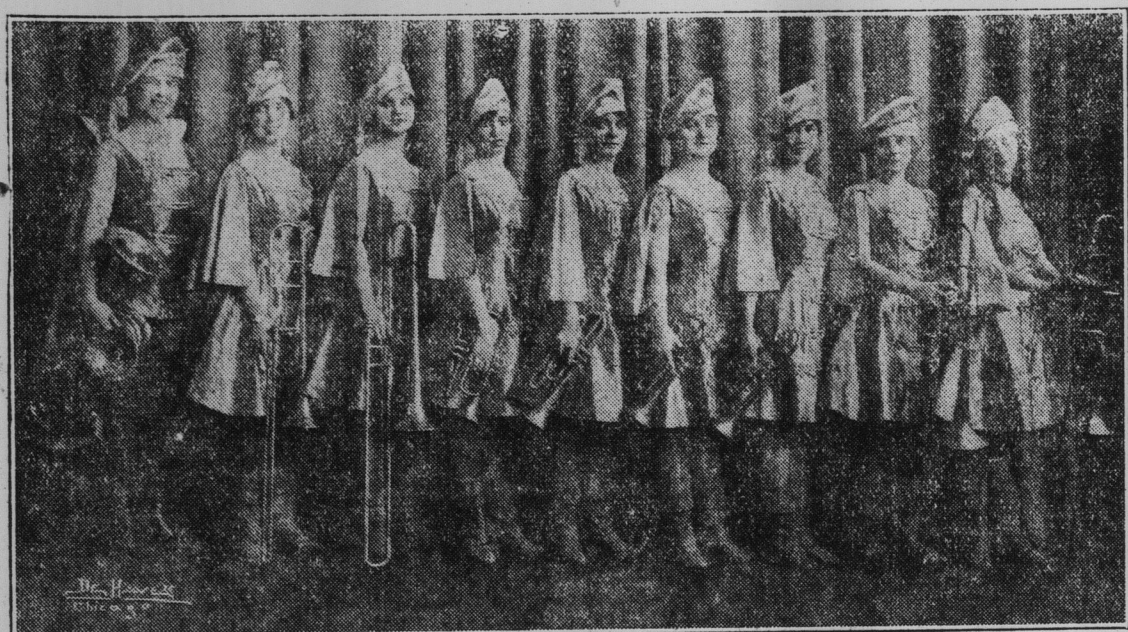


# AMERICA'S PREMIER VAUDEVILLE MUSICAL ORGANIZATION

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## WORLD FOOD SITUATION

Trenchant Review is Made in Statement by Mr. Hoover

In a statement dated with the world food situation, Herbert Hoover, United States Food Administrator, said in part:

"If we can produce such economies in consumption and such stimulation of production in the United States and Canada as will enable us to feed the Allies absolutely from this continent, and thus enable them in the final analysis to live without sending a ship farther afield than our Atlantic seaboard, we can resist the submarine menace, we can resist the Canadian and United States supplies of wheat, upon a normal export basis, for approximately 350,000,000 bushels short of the Allies' needs. If by conservation measures in Canada and the United States we can increase the export by 150,000,000 bushels we will have reduced the deficiency to 200,000,000 bushels. This we could do if our people would eat one pound less of wheat flour per week and one pound of corn meal instead."

"The production of more food is today a critical necessity for the preservation of these people and the maintenance of their constancy in the war. Every pound of fat is as sure of service as every bullet, and every hog is of greater value to the winning of this war than a shell."

"Every spare full of earth turned by the farmer and every animal reared is lessening human suffering and guaranteeing the liberty of the world."

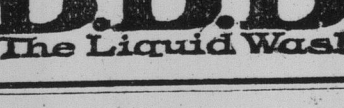

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## New War Orders Should Sustain Canada's Trade

(Financial Post.)

Current events are having an important and direct bearing upon the business situation of the present and the outlook for the future. Outstanding in its direct effect is the further announcement made by The Financial Post this week regarding shell orders from the United States. This announcement not only bears out the forecast of last week, but gives details of the business being placed. From information gathered from different sources it would appear that Canadian manufacturers are to have all the orders for certain shells which they can handle, for the time being at least, and the possibilities are that the total volume of business will eventually run many times the \$50,000,000 which is estimated for the orders now in sight.

The effect of this business upon conditions in Canada will be very beneficial. Not only does it mean a new lease of life for many of the munitions plants which were closed down, but the fact that the money for the production will be coming into the country will be of greater benefit to the country's financial position than the orders from Great Britain which are being handled on credit.

Further it is more than possible that the shell orders, which are being accompanied by inquiries for shipbuilding supplies and ship equipment, will be followed by other orders for more general supplies. Already there has been business in certain textile lines and this may be extended as the number of men under arms increases. An evidence of the effect on business of calling men to the colors is also seen in Canada in the fact that inquiries are being made regarding the purchase of large quantities of footwear for the men being called out under the Conscription Act.

The War Loan

The Dominion War Loan is also an important factor in the business situation. Its success is generally assured, but the extent to which the amount is subscribed will undoubtedly have its effect upon the credit position of Canada and her ability to handle business from Great Britain and the other Allies which must be accepted on deferred payment basis. Canadians owe it to themselves as a matter of loyalty and as a matter of business to subscribe largely to the loan. The money will all be spent in Canada. Not only will it mean another lease of life in many lines of industry but it will permit those supplies going to the Allies of which they stand so much in need.

Altogether with the prospects of a successful flotation of the war loan, and renewed war orders from various sources, together with high prices for agricultural products, the outlook is for a continued period of reasonable prosperity, although there is an increasing realization of the fact that the war is a very serious issue and that if we are to play our part in it there must be a conservation of financial resources on a scale much different from that which has been generally observed. There is no need for hoarding, but extravagance should be reduced to the minimum.

The idea of soldiers from New Zealand, Australia and other dominions is not to leave this job unfinished until Germany has received the knock-out blow, and till all repetition of the horrors of the last two years has been made impossible not only for generations, but for centuries to come.—Hon. W. F. Massey.

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## STRENGTH OF THE BOLSHEVIKI

Long Agitating For a Separate Peace

Solution of Bread Crisis!

Troops at the Front Misled Into Belief That Lenin Had Control of Government and War Was Over

In explanation of the events in Petrograd it is necessary to recall the circumstances which led to the predominance of the Bolshevik or Maximilianist influence in the Soviet, otherwise the Council of Workers' and Soldiers' Delegates, says the Petrograd correspondent of the Times, who is now in London. The Bolshevik, under the guidance of Nikolai Lenin, a propagandist who returned to Russia under German auspices, had long been agitating for the conclusion of a separate peace and had systematically indoctrinated the ignorant masses and the demoralized soldiery of Petrograd with the idea that peace would bring a solution of the bread crisis and would enable the peasants to take the land.

Decided the Troops.

In July, when the Russian armies assumed the offensive and desperate attacks west of Tarnopol had almost exhausted the enemy reserves, the Bolshevik organized an armed rising in Petrograd. At that time they did not have a majority of the Soviet, but Bolshevik agents in the wireless service misrepresented the facts and the troops at the front were misled into the belief that the Bolshevik had obtained control of the government and that the war was over. Some divisions opened in front of the enemy and the Russian armies retreated panic-stricken. General Korniloff, assuming the high command, introduced the death penalty and saved the armies of the whole of Southern Russia from the enemy. Premier Kerensky temporized with General Korniloff on the latter's demand for stern measures to introduce discipline into the army and order into the country and within the extreme faction of the Soviet.
