There are in the Province more than 600 Common Schools and 30 combined Common and Grammar Schools, at which upwards of 20,000 children are instructed. These Schools are supported partly by grants of the Legislature—and partly by individual subscriptions. The total sum contributed by the Legislature in 1840 towards supporting Education exceeded £7000, and in 1841 amounted to £6000.
