LEONCAVALLO WAS THE COMPOSER OF "FAGLIACCIO"

Ruggiero Leoncavallo, noted composer, who died in Rome a few days ago, was born in Naples in 1858. He received his musical education in the Conservatory at Naples and at the age of sixteen made a tour as a pianist. Leoncavallo probably was best known for his opera "Faglieccio," which he composed in 1891.
