pains to adorn the pulpit with the best flowers they could obtain, while the latter have afterwards made good use of them in the sick rooms of the congregation.

In these and in other ways we feel that we have made progress, and look forward to still better work in 1894.

There are at present at college studying for the ministry three honorary and one active members and two more actives preparing for the work.

In concluding our report we would earnestly request the hearty support of all the members of the church in the work we have undertaken for Christ and the Church.
