The report of the Committee on Education was now taken up.

Dr. DAVIDSON moved, seconded by Rural Dean LONGHURST, that the report of Committee on Education be referred back to the Committee for further information, to report at the next meeting of Synod—*Carried*.

Moved by Canon MUSSEN, seconded by Mr. E. R. SMITH, that the thanks of Synod be and are hereby tendered to the Rector of Montreal and members of the choir of the Cathedral for the opportunity furnished the Synod this day of attending the beautiful and solemn service held in commemoration of the interment of H. R. H. the Duke of Clarence and Avondale—*Carried*.

The discussion of the motion of Mr. Thornloe was then resumed.

The Bishop here entered the room and resumed the chair.

After some discussion, with the consent of the Synod, Mr. Thornloe's motion was withdrawn, and the following one substituted: Moved by Mr. D. R. McCORD, seconded by Rev. Dr. NORTON, that the notice to apply to the Legislature to amend the Act to enable women to vote at vestries be postponed to the session next after the approaching Synod—*Carried unanimously*.

Moved by the CHANCELLOR, seconded by Dean CARMICHAEL, that the allowance by this Synod of \$500 per annum towards the income of the Bishop of Algoma be continued for the period of one year—*Carried*.

Moved by the DEAN, seconded by Dr. DAVIDSON, that the motion read this morning in reference to illegal lotteries be passed with the omission of the word illegal—*Carried*.

Moved by Rev. A. FRENCH, seconded by Mr. D. R. McCORD, that this Synod desires to pronounce in the strongest way against all methods of raising money by means of raffles or any other game of chance—*Carried*.

Moved by Rev. T. E. CUNNINGHAM, seconded by Archdeacon LINDSAY, that this Synod, under a deep sense of dependence upon the Providence of Almighty God, and recognizing the appropriate action of the house of Bishops in authorizing a special form of Harvest Thanksgiving, would hereby, through His Lordship the Bishop of the Diocese of Montreal, also respectfully petition the aforesaid House to set forth and authorize a special form of service suitable for the Rogation days—*Carried*.
