





CURIOUS HISTORY. At the West India Docks (244 acress in extent) an enormous business is carried on in receiving frozen meat from Australia, New Zealand, and Bue-nos Ayres, or from insulated barges conveying it from vessels discharged at other docks. The rum vaults, afford-ing storage for 40,000 puncheons, are lit by reflectors, no candle or lamp being allowed there. In the corner of this dock lies the President, now used as a training ship. This name has a curious history. She was originally the gunboat Gannet. She took the place of the frigate President, built in 1829 on exactly the same lines as the President which was captured from the
