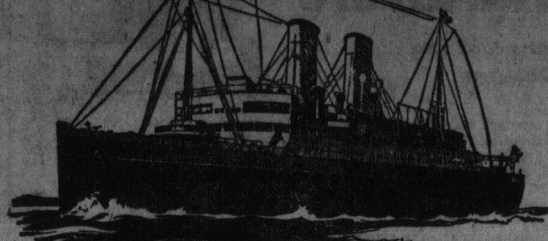

Monoclass Cabin Service

"Monoclass" means one class. Monoclass Cabin Steamships carry one class of cabin passengers only, instead of two (first and second).

The Canadian Pacific Monoclass Cabin Service to Europe is a moderate rate service, the rates of passage being only slightly in excess of regular second-class fare on two-cabin class ships.
